

# Taylor Borough Burning Ordinance Permit Application

Regulated under Ordinance # 7 Of 2014

“To regulate and prohibit the burning, ignition and combustion of rubbish, garbage and other materials within the Borough of Taylor, and to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents”

“Obtain from the Borough Code Enforcement Officer, at a cost of \$5.00 (Five-Dollars), a Fire Pit Permit generally authorizing the use of the proposed fire pit at the proposed location on the property.”

## **Applicant to initial each section, denoting the conditions are fully understood.**

- a. \_\_\_\_\_ Any fire pit shall be constructed and operated in a safe manner, and shall not be located closer than twenty (20) feet to any building, structure or property line.
- b. \_\_\_\_\_ Only clean seasoned firewood or charcoal may be burned. No burning of trash leaves, brush, and pressure treated wood or painted wood is permitted.
- c. \_\_\_\_\_ All openings in the container or fire pit must be covered with wire mesh or other non-combustible screening materials that will prevent the passage of sparks or embers.
- d. \_\_\_\_\_ All fires shall be constantly attended by at least one (1) adult person until they are completely extinguished. A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher with a minimum 4-A rating or other approved on-site fire extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, water barrel's., water bucket or garden hose shall be available for immediate utilization.
- e. \_\_\_\_\_ No such fire or container may be used on any porch, deck, balcony or other portion of a building.
- f. \_\_\_\_\_ Fires are not permitted during adverse wind and weather conditions.
- g. \_\_\_\_\_ Fires shall not be permitted to smolder.
- h. \_\_\_\_\_ All open fires as set forth herein shall be extinguished no later than 12:00 P.M. (Midnight).
- i. \_\_\_\_\_ Any fire permitted to burn in an unsafe manner under adverse weather conditions, unsupervised, determined unsafe by the Fire Chief or Police Officer(s), or in violation of any provision of this Ordinance, shall be extinguished immediately upon demand by such official.
