

Taylor Borough  
Special Meeting  
June 15, 2016

The Taylor Borough Council held a Special Meeting on Wednesday, June 15, 2016 at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.

On Roll Call, Councilman DeAngelo, Yes; Councilman Fallon, Yes; Councilman Tigie, Yes; Councilman Derenick, No; Councilman Digwood, Yes; Councilman McKeel, Yes; Councilman Mickavicz, Yes; Mayor Praschak, No.

President Mickavicz chaired the meeting.

First, the Chairman entertained a motion to consider an Ordinance #6 of 2016, amending Ordinance #3 of 2000 and Ordinance #4 OF 2000, by hereby deleting and readopting a new section 2.3 organization; 3.5 general qualifications; 4.4 written examination; 4.6 veterans preference points; 4.8 physical fitness testing, of the Civil Service rules and regulations for the Borough of Taylor Municipal Civil Service Commission. Solicitor Jones gave a brief overview and a discussion followed. The Chair asked for public input and there was none at this time. A motion was made by Councilman Tigie and seconded by Councilman McKeel. On roll call: Councilman DeAngelo – Yes; Councilman Fallon – Yes; Councilman Tigie – Yes; Councilman Digwood – Yes; Councilman McKeel – Yes; Councilman Mickavicz – Yes. The Ordinance was adopted.

Next, the Chairman entertained a motion to ratify a Memorandum of Understanding with the Taylor Police Officer's Association. Solicitor Jones gave a detailed overview of all changes. A discussion followed. A motion was made by Councilman Tigie and seconded by Councilman McKeel. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor except for Councilman Mickavicz who abstained from the vote. The motion passed.

Next, Councilman Fallon asked the Solicitor if the Condemnation agreement was executed. Solicitor Jones stated that the Borough did not receive a letter of credit or financial guarantee from Taylor 1, LLC as of today. A lengthy discussion between Council, Solicitor Jones and Mr. Zeleniak followed. As a

result of this, the Chairman asked for this meeting to be recessed until Tuesday, June 21, 2016 at 7:00 P.M.

Next, Councilman Fallon asked that we advertise for people to use caution driving through Taylor a week before PPL starts changing the LED lights throughout the Borough.

Next, the Chairman advised that there will be an executive session immediately following this meeting to discuss a personnel issue.

Next, the Chairman entertained a motion to accept a resignation from Officer Wanda Crespo effectively immediately. Motioned by Councilman McKeel and seconded by Councilman DeAngelo. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor except for Councilman Mickavicz who abstained from the vote. The motion passed.

Next, the Chairman entertained a motion to accept a request from Officer Jared Beilman to take a leave of absence effective June 18, 2016, for up to 8 months. Motioned by Councilman Tigie and seconded by Councilman Fallon. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor except for Councilman Mickavicz who abstained from the vote. The motion passed.

Lastly, the Chairman asked the public for any comments or input.

The Chairman entertained a motion to recess. Motioned by Councilman McKeel and seconded by Councilman Tigie. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor except for Councilman Mickavicz who abstained from the vote. The motion passed.
