Reconvened Regular Monthly Meeting

Reconvened from November 08, 2017

The Taylor Borough Council held its reconvened monthly meeting on Thursday, November 16, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.
