Resolution No. 9 of 2018

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TAYLOR BOROUGH COUNCIL,  
LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
TO ACCEPT DONATIONS FOR AN HONORS BANNER PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, as a matter of public convenience and welfare the Borough is accepting donations for the purchase, printing and installation of a Honors Banner Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Taylor by this Resolution intends to promulgate regulations for the donations for the Honors Banner Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by Taylor Borough Council of Taylor, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania, as follows,

Section 1. The Borough is accepting unconditional donations, the cost of which will defray, but is not limited to, the purchase, printing and installation of Honors Banners, to be placed at various locations throughout the Borough of Taylor, PA. The Borough makes no representation that tendered funds are sufficient for the Honors Banner Program. Further, the Borough is not responsible nor does it represent that it will install Honors Banners for the amounts tendered. In the event the Honors Banner Program is not undertaken the Borough reserves the right to use donations for the improvements or maintenance of recreational facilities and programs. The Borough intends on establishing a separate account for donations for its convenience and no third party rights are created thereunder; but reserves the right to mingle and co-mingle all funds tendered into its general fund and that any donation will not be treated as a separate capital.

Section 2. The Borough, in recognition of donations, reserves the right to place a banner from donors. The donors have no legal right or expectation as to the placement of a banner or the verbiage on the banner. The Borough reserves the right to place and remove a banner at any time or from time to time and to modify, delete, or change any language on the banner.

Section 3. The improvements will be the sole property of the municipality and will be located, relocated, or removed at such times and in such areas as are deemed solely acceptable to the Borough.

Section 4. In addition to all other rights and privileges reserved, the Borough may at any time abolish, modify, amend, or otherwise change or terminate the Honors Banner Program and any and all facilities or improvements. In the event of such change, reallocation, or termination, funds tendered shall remain the property of the Borough for its unrestricted use.

Section 5. The Borough shall not be liable in any way for the purchase, location, design, size, shape, condition, materials, labor, inspection, maintenance, repair, or replacement, of the Honors Banners or related improvements or plaque(s), memorials, to any applicant/donor.

Section 6. The Applicant/Donor hereby waives any and all claim(s), action(s), reimbursement(s), and damage(s) against the Borough, its officers, agents, employees, engineers, committees, or volunteers with respect to any action arising out of the Honors Banner Program, including but not limited to the donation, donations of time, money or materials, installation of any banner, or language

thereon.

Section 7. This program is being instituted for the benefit of the Borough and does not create any legal rights in the Applicant/Donor including, but not limited to, contractual actions against the Borough, its officers, agents, employees, committees or volunteers.

- All Applications will be reviewed on a First Come, First Served basis
- Borough reserves the right to refuse any language for legitimate other than those set forth in this list.
- The Program is non-political, non-partisan;
- Banners will Include the Following:
  - Veteran's Name and Rank
  - Photograph
  - Tour of Duty/Country and Years served
  - Branch of Military
  - Sponsor
- The Borough is not responsible for replacing Banners that are stolen, damaged or destroyed due to age, vandalism, or any acts of nature including high winds. Any loss or damage to an installed Banner will be handled at the discretion of the Borough of Taylor.
- After the course of (2) years, the Banner will be permanently removed and given to the service person or sponsor.
