

**Taylor Borough
Special Council Meeting
September 17, 2020**

The Taylor Borough Council held a Special Council Meeting on Thursday, September 17, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. via Teleconference due to State of Emergency – COVID-19.

President Mickavicz stated that the teleconference was advertised in a newspaper of general circulation that ran on September 9, 2020, it instructed the public that the agenda was available online as well as the front window of the Borough Building and that if any resident had any comment or input on any agenda item that they can submit it to the Borough Secretary through email or via phone call. There were none.

The legal advertisement which ran on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 read as follows and will be part of the minutes: NOTICE is hereby given that the Taylor Borough Council will hold a Special Meeting via teleconference on September 17, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. for general business and to vote on enacting AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 2 OF 2020 TO ESTABLISH OR RE-ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ALONG PORTIONS OF SOUTH MAIN STREET, NORTH MAIN STREET AND UNION STREET, IN ORDER TO IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY AND SIGHT DISTANCE. The Meeting Agenda can be viewed online at taylorborough.com and will be posted at the Taylor Borough Building, front door window by 4:30 P.M. on Friday, September 11, 2020 or by requesting one be sent by email or phone call to the Borough Secretary. The press is invited. A copy of the full text of the proposed Ordinance may be examined or a copy may be obtained for a charge not greater than the cost thereof in the Managers Office at the Municipal Building, 122 Union St Taylor, PA during any business day between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM. President Mickavicz entertained a motion to consider Ordinance # 5 of 2020, amending Ordinance # 2 of 2020, an Ordinance to establish or re-establish a no parking zone along portions of South Main Street, North Main Street and Union Street, in order to improve public safety and sight distance. Having received a unanimous vote, Ordinance # 5 of 2020 was adopted.
