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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (“MOU”) is entered into this 22nd day of February, 2024, by and between the City of Scranton, a Pennsylvania City with its principal place of business at 340 N. Washington Avenue, Scranton, PA 18503 (the “City”), and Taylor Borough, (hereinafter collectively the “Parties”).

Nothing in this MOU should be construed as limiting or impeding the basic spirit of cooperation which exists between the Parties listed above.

WHEREAS, the Parties have common areas of responsibility in meeting the requirements of the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (“MS4”); and

WHEREAS, the Parties recognize the need to provide for cooperative stormwater planning and management in the City of Scranton and the surrounding Lackawanna Valley region; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have sought to establish partnerships and agreements for jointly implementing regional stormwater management solutions; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to formalize their roles and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, this MOU will serve as a foundation for a cooperative and mutually beneficial working relationship between the Parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises mutually exchanged, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by all, the Parties agree as follows:

I. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a general working understanding between the Parties regarding their roles and responsibilities in implementing regional stormwater management solutions, and to formalize the Parties’ commitment to accomplishing this goal.

II. Roles and Responsibilities

The Parties agree to accept certain roles and responsibilities regarding the cooperative development of regional stormwater management solutions. These include, to the extent authorized by law, the following:

- A. The Parties intend to work cooperatively to implement regional stormwater management solutions.
- B. The Parties intend to work cooperatively to develop an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement.

- C. The Parties intend to work cooperatively to establish an appropriate structure to carry out the services to be identified through this partnership.
- D. The Parties intend to work cooperatively in developing a budget and mechanism for funding the work to be performed through this partnership.
- E. The Parties intend to work cooperatively in developing and implementing a community and public outreach and education plan.

III. Additional Parties

The Parties intend to account for opportunities to jointly cooperate with additional entities that may join the agreement in the future.

IV. Term and Termination

This MOU shall become effective upon approval and signature by the Parties and shall remain in effect until termination by either party. Either party may terminate this MOU upon 90 days' written notice to the other party. The provisions of this MOU will be reviewed annually and amended or supplemented as may be mutually agreed upon by the Parties in writing.

V. Other MOUs

There are no superseding MOUs on this topic between the Parties hereto.

VI. Amendment

This MOU, or any part or paragraph hereof, may not be modified or amended except by a written instrument executed by the Parties. The Parties agree to explore in good faith any amendments or modifications to this MOU that the Parties may deem warranted in the future.

VII. Counterparts

This MOU may be executed in any number of counterparts which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same document. To evidence the fact that it has executed this MOU, a party may send a copy of its executed counterpart to the other party by electronic transmission. In such event, such party shall forthwith deliver to the other party an original counterpart of this MOU executed by such party.
