

**Taylor Borough
Special Council Meeting
January 17, 2024**

The Taylor Borough Council held a Special Council Meeting on Wednesday, January 17, 2024, at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.

President Mickavicz asked if there were any comments or input on tonight's Agenda Item from the public. There were none.

Next, President Mickavicz entertained a motion to combine items C and D in order to correct the expiration dates to 2028 and 2029 (respectively). Councilman Maldonado made the motion and seconded by Councilman DeAngelo. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor. The motion passed.

Next, President Mickavicz entertained a motion to appoint Bob Connor to the Planning Commission for a 4year term. A motion was made by Councilman McKeel and seconded by Councilman Nezlo. Next, President Mickavicz asked Borough Manager Cindy to reach out to Define DeAngelo to serve as interim tax Collector. He asked if anyone had any other names to reach out to council. He said that Mrs. DeAngelo already knows the process. Action can't be taken until after Feb 1, 2024. She would need to get her certification in 60 days and a background check.

Next, Councilman Nezlo asked with the Councils approval to send a letter to the Riverside School District letting them know that the Council would like them to appoint a Crossing Guard at the Stadium on Main Street. The Police Chief is available to train the candidate.

Next, Councilman McKeel asked the Finance Committee to look into hiring more Full Time Police Officers as funds are available.

Next, Councilman Digwood said that the Public Works Committee will be interviewing and applicant for the vacant DPW position.

Next, President Mickavicz called an executive session following the meeting regarding benefits for an employee.

Next, President Mickavicz asked the Public if they had any comments or questions. There were none.

Next, Solicitor Jones requested an Executive Session with the Council immediately following this meeting regarding a personnel issue.
