

**Taylor Borough
Emergency Meeting
July 16, 2021**

The Taylor Borough Council held an Emergency Meeting on Friday, July 16, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.

On Roll Call: Councilman Naro, No; Councilman DeAngelo, Yes; Councilman Fallon, Yes; Councilman Tigue, Yes; Councilman Digwood, Yes; Councilman McKeel, Yes; President Mickavicz, Yes; Mayor Praschak, No.

President Mickavicz stated that the purpose of this meeting is to avoid any problems due to Mayor Praschak being out of town on Monday, July 19th.
