

**Taylor Borough
Council Special Meeting Minutes
May 5, 2025**

The Taylor Borough Council held its regular monthly meeting on Monday, May 5th, at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.

President Mickavicz chaired the meeting.

President Mickavicz opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

On Roll Call: Councilman Fox, Yes; Councilman Maldonato, Yes; Councilman McKeel, Yes; Councilman Nezlo, Yes; Councilman Digwood, Yes; Councilman DeAngelo, Absent; President Mickavicz, Yes; Mayor Kavulich, Absent.

Next, President Mickavicz asked if anyone from the Public had any comments or input on the agenda. There were none.

Next, President Mickavicz entertained a motion to award the lowest bid of \$1,182,942.75 from American Asphalt for the 2025 Paving Project. A brief discussion followed. A motion was made by Councilman Digwood and seconded by Councilman McKeel. A voice vote was called, and all Council Members were in favor. The motion passed.

Next, President Mickavicz entertained a motion to adopt Resolution No. 4 of 2025 authorizing Taylor Borough to enter into a loan agreement with the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Bank (Loan # 521342) and appointing the President of the Council to execute any documents needed to finalize said loan on behalf of Taylor Borough. A motion was made by Councilman Maldonato and seconded by Councilman McKeel. A voice vote was called, and all Council Members were in favor. The motion passed.

Next, President Mickavicz asked if there was any public input. Edward Fortuna asked the total loan amount. President Mickavicz stated it was \$1.6 million dollar loan specifically for paving. Councilman Digwood explained that that was the estimate for what would be needed for paving this year. A brief discussion followed.

Lastly, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
