6. **For 7-10-2024 Agenda:** Discussion on bid results of 2 Police Vehicles:
 - 2018 Ford F-350 Super Duty: 6.2liter, V8, Automatic, 4WD w/Police upfit package. 4,146 miles, Mint Condition
 - 2009 Dodge Caravan: Good Condition, APX 48,000 miles.

7. **For 7-10-2024 Agenda:** Discussion regarding quotes for lining of Sanitary Sewer Line on Fourth Street:
 - Able Recon: \$54.65/L.F., 10in. pipe diameter, \$49.65/ L.F., 8in. pipe diameter, cutting of protruding laterals \$500. Each, Mobilization \$6,835.00 (**270 ft 8' x \$49.65 = \$13,405.50, 83 ft 10" x \$54.65 = \$4,535.95, cut 3 Laterals @\$500.00 = \$1,500.00, Mobilization \$6,835.00, Total: \$26,276.45.**) Received 6/17/24.
 - U.S. Pipelining LLC.: \$260.00/ L.F. 10in. pipe diameter, \$250.00/L.F. 8in pipe diameter (**270 ft 8" x \$250.00 = \$67,500.00, 83 ft 10" x \$260.00 = \$21,580.00, Total: \$89,080.**) Received 6/13/24.
 - PPM: \$135.00 to \$155.00/L.F. 10in. pipe diameter, \$130.00 to \$150.00/L.F. 8in. pipe diameter, lateral grinding approx. \$10,000. (**270 ft 8" x \$130.00 = \$35,100.00, 83 ft 10" x \$135.00 = \$11,205.00, Grind Laterals \$10,000.00, Total \$56,305.00.**) Received 6/20/24.
 - InfraHorse will perform an Ultraviolet Cured in Place Pipe (UV CIPP) Trenchless rehabilitation on Fourth Street in Taylor Borough to a sanitary sewer for (**270 ft of 8' ft and 83 ft of 10'**), and grind out 3 laterals, without any excavation required). The introductory quote is for \$15,000.00 and submitted on 6/10/2024.
