

Taylor Borough Reconvened Council Meeting

November 20, 2018

Reconvened from November 14, 2018

The Taylor Borough Council held a Special Meeting on Tuesday, November 20, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.

On Roll Call, Councilman DeAngelo, Yes; Councilman Fallon, Yes; Councilman Tigue, Yes; Councilman Derenick, No; Councilman Digwood, Yes; Councilman McKeel, Yes; Councilman Mickavicz, Yes; Mayor Praschak, No.

President Mickavicz chaired the meeting.

This meeting is reconvened and is a continuation from November 14, 2018 Council Meeting.

We will discuss the Borough Secretary's Position. Mr. Zeleniak read a letter from Kristi Evans rescinding her resignation which was submitted to council on November 14, 2018. The letter was dated November 19, 2018. The Chairman entertained a motion to accept the rescinding of Kristi Evans' resignation. A motion was made by Councilman Tigue and seconded by Councilman McKeel. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor. The Motion was passed.

Next, the Chairman entertained a motion to allow Officer Brian Holland to attend SWAT training in Maryland. A Forty Hour Week - Paid straight time with no overtime from December 10, 2018 to December 14, 2018. This training will be paid by Lackawanna County Chief of Police Association. Training, Lodging, and Meals are provided. Officer Holland will be using the Police Silver Van for travel. A motion was made by Councilman Tigue and seconded by Councilman DeAngelo. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor. The Motion was passed.

Next, The Solicitor talked about Rail Road Business. Norfolk bought Canadian Pacific and we received \$14,000 Real Estate Transfer Tax. Being a utility, they are disputing paying this tax and are negotiating a different amount to be paid back. The Chairman entertained a motion to authorize Solicitor Jones to initiate a Settlement Agreement. A motion was made by Councilman Tigue and seconded by Councilman McKeel. A voice vote was called and all Council Members were in favor. The Motion passed.

Lastly, the Chairman asked for any public comments or input. There was none.

The Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
