

**Taylor Borough  
Special Council Meeting  
January 22, 2020**

The Taylor Borough Council held a Special Council Meeting on Wednesday, January 22, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.

On Roll Call – Councilman Naro, Yes; Councilman DeAngelo, Yes; Councilman Fallon, Yes; Councilman Tigue, Yes; Councilman Digwood, Yes; Councilman McKeel, No; President Mickavicz, Yes; Mayor Praschak, No.

President Mickavicz chaired the meeting. He asked if the public had any comments or input on the Agenda items – There were none.

President Mickavicz entertained a motion to consider Ordinance No. 1 of 2020, establishing two-way traffic of the 100 block of Middle Street, Taylor, PA and there shall be no parking in this section of Middle Street for a distance of 250 feet from South Main Street to termination. A motion to adopt by Councilman Tigue and seconded by Councilman DeAngelo. A Roll Call Vote was conducted – Councilman Naro, Yes; Councilman DeAngelo, Yes; Councilman Fallon, Yes; Councilman Tigue, Yes; Councilman Digwood, Yes; President Mickavicz, Yes. Having received a unanimous vote, Ordinance No. 1 of 2020 was adopted.

Next, President Mickavicz entertained a motion to consider Ordinance No. 2 of 2020, establishing or re-establishing a no parking zone along portions of South Main Street, North Main Street, and Union Street in order to improve public safety and sight distance. Solicitor Jones gave a brief overview. A motion was made by Councilman Tigue and seconded by Councilman Fallon. A Roll Call was conducted – Councilman Naro, Yes; Councilman DeAngelo, Yes; Councilman Fallon, Yes; Councilman Tigue, Yes; Councilman Digwood, Yes; President Mickavicz, Yes. Having received a unanimous vote, Ordinance No. 2 of 2020 was adopted.

Next, President Mickavicz entertained a motion to hire Patricia L. Zimmer for a part-time clerk position at the Taylor Community Center. The required clearances (Act 34, Act 114 and Act 151) have been submitted. The starting hourly rate of pay is \$10.00 per hour. The position is an on call, as needed with no guarantee of hours. A motion was made by Councilman Digwood and seconded by Councilman Tigue. A Roll Call was conducted – Councilman Naro, Yes; Councilman DeAngelo, Yes; Councilman Fallon, Yes; Councilman Tigue, Yes; Councilman Digwood, Yes; President Mickavicz, Yes. Having received a unanimous vote, the motion passed.

Next, President Mickavicz asked the Public for any input or comments. There were none.
