## Taylor Borough Special Council Meeting January 22, 2020

The Taylor Borough Council held a Special Council Meeting on Wednesday, January 22, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. at the Taylor Municipal Building, 122 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania.

President Mickavicz chaired the meeting. He asked if the public had any comments or input on the Agenda items – There were none.

The required clearances (Act 34, Act 114 and Act 151) have been submitted. The starting hourly rate of pay is \$10.00 per hour. The position is an on call, as needed with no guarantee of hours.
